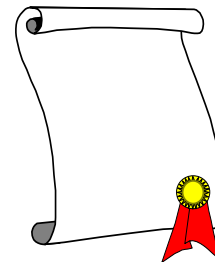
BASIC GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

English	4 Credits
Social Science (Class of 2014- must include Economics) (including World History, US History and Government)	3 Credits
Mathematics (Class of 2014 – 4 credits required – must include Algebra II)	3 Credits
Science	3 Credits
Physical Education	.50 Credit
Health	.50 Credit
Business/Tech/Fine Arts/Foreign Lang	1 Credit
Electives (Class of 2014- must include 1 credit of Fine Arts)	6 Credits

TOTAL Minimum 21 credits to graduate

SHS Honors Diploma -Need SEVEN of these eight criteria

- 4 credits of English
- 4 credits of math (including Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, and one higher math)
- 4 credits of science (including chemistry and physics)
- 4 credits of social studies
- 3 credits of foreign language OR 2 credits each of two foreign languages
- 1 credit of fine arts
- 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale through the end of the third grading period of the senior year
- 27 on the ACT OR 1210 on the SAT (combined Critical Reading and Math scores)



College Entrance Recommendations

- 4 years of English
- 4 years of Math (including Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry)
- 3-4 years of Science (including Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- 3-4 years of Social Studies
- 2-3 years of Foreign Language
- 1 year of Fine, Applied or Performing Arts
