What We're Learning:

Math: Students will be doing some online math review on Ohio's testing website to prepare for their math assessment on Tuesday and Wednesday of this week. Please be sure your child has headphones at school for this test! Remind your child to show all their mathematical thinking on paper, check over their work, and do their best on this test!

Reading: As we continue to read biographies, students will learn to summarize the achievements and qualities that make their subject an important person. Students will be working within their book club group to compile this and other important information to prepare to teach others about their subject!

Writing: This week, we will be studying the similarities between fairy tale writing and narrative writing. Students will recall all that they have learned about writing narratives and will have opportunities to practice this type of writing over the next two weeks. On Thursday 5/20, students will take their writing assessment to show their ability to write a narrative piece with!

Science: This week, students will use all that they have learned about animal adaptations to create a mini research report. Students will choose one animal to research and learn about the adaptations the animal has that helps it to survive.
