

April 1 & 2 Chromebook/Hard Copy Workbook Drive-Through Pick Up Reminder

REMINDER: On Wednesday and Thursday, April 1 and 2, Lewis, Parkside and Roxbury will have staggered drive-through pick up opportunities for families who would like a district-issued Chromebook for home use. Hard copy math and word study workbooks may also be picked up at the same time.

Technology Access – Chromebooks for At-Home Use

Moving fully to a digital platform may present significant challenges for some of our families. Please be sure to contact your building principal immediately if you do not have Internet access at home so the school can put a plan in place for your child's continued learning at home. To expand access in your home to digital learning tools, we are able to provide **ONE Chromebook per family** in grades K-4. This is optional, and students may access the online learning using any device. However, we know that many families could use this additional device to better manage their schedules at home.

A staggered pick-up time is scheduled for noon to 6 p.m. on April 1 & 2 at your child's elementary school.

Additional Materials Pick-Up Opportunity

Students in grades K-4 will all have access to their enVision math workbook and their Words Their Way word study workbook electronically through the Pearson educational site, which will be linked in their teacher's Google Classroom. The log-in information kindergarten and first grade students need to access those online workbooks will also be sent by their teacher by April 3.

Some students did pick up their math and word study workbooks during our first opportunity for hard copy materials pick up. However, we are providing a second opportunity for students to obtain the hard copy workbooks if they need them.

All students have engaged in online learning throughout the school year. Our students in grades K, 1 and 2 have not used those digital resources independently every day. All lessons and materials are available online and can be printed if families prefer through the Pearson site. There is no expectation that families pick up the math and word study workbooks.

Hard copy workbooks for math and word study will be available during the same pick-up times on April 1 & 2 as when Chromebooks are distributed.

The optional pick-up opportunity for Chromebooks and/or workbooks will be a **drive-up distribution only**. A map detailing the pick-up location at your school is attached. All students and parents must stay in their cars. We will be practicing recommended social distancing for the pick-up in accordance with public health recommendations.

Optional Chromebook/Hard Copy Pick-Up Schedule

Wednesday, April 1, and Thursday, April 2, from noon to 6 p.m. at Lewis, Parkside and Roxbury.

Kindergarten: Noon to 1 p.m.

1st Grade: 1 to 2 p.m.

2nd Grade: 2 to 3 p.m.

3rd Grade: 3 to 4 p.m.

4th Grade: 4 to 5 p.m.

Any Grade: 5 to 6 p.m.

(If you requested materials for more than one student, you only need to come one time and may choose the time that is most convenient for you. We understand families are on very different schedules now, so if you are unable to come during your recommended time slot, again select the time that works best. We are trying to space out arrivals as much as possible. We will appreciate everyone's patience as we match materials and requests with cars safely when they arrive in the pick-up line.)
