

Hello Comet Freshmen, Sophomores, Juniors and Families!

Like you, we are so disappointed to close out the school year without a traditional last day. But as the school year winds down, we need to plan ahead as there are still many things we need to do to fully bring the school year to a close for our students. Please be sure to read each section carefully and follow all directions as outlined.

We will share more information about the other upcoming Virtual Awards Programs shortly so we can celebrate the accomplishments of our 9th, 10th and 11th grade students.

The Last Day of Instruction for Grades 9-11 will be Friday, May 29.

Each student has been assigned a specific 30-minute time slot the week of June 1 (please see attached schedule) to come to SHS to close out the year. **Students ONLY will be permitted to enter the building during their assigned time, through their assigned entrance.** Students will be required to check in when they arrive and then check out when finished at the same location where they entered the building. Social distancing will be maintained at all times and students must wear masks or face coverings.

Only 10 students per grade are scheduled to enter the building every 30 minutes. Students should follow the directions below as quickly as possible and not congregate or socialize in the building or the parking lot. Students must follow staff directions as well as floor markings to ensure proper distancing is maintained throughout their time in the building. This is for the health and safety of students, families and staff.

Entrance:

Juniors: Pool Lobby

Sophomores: Commons

Freshmen: Main Entrance

Locker Clean-Out/Materials Return:

Students will receive a checklist upon entering the building listing the closure stations they need to visit.

Items to Return: Students must return all textbooks, College Credit Plus course books, school band or orchestra instruments, and orchestra or choir uniforms.

Locker Clean-Out: Students in grades 9 and 11 must keep their vocabulary workbooks to use next year.

PE Locker Clean-Out: Students will gather any items remaining from their gym class lockers. Remember to leave the PE lock on the locker.

Fees: Families are encouraged to log onto EZpay to take care of any outstanding student fees.

Materials Pick-Up: Students will be expected to gather awards, art projects and any pre-ordered summer reading books.

Medication Pick-Up: Any medications students have in the school clinic must be picked up by PARENTS ONLY. Parents may pick up medications during the grades 9-11 pick-up times by buzzing for entrance at Door 27 across from the stadium in the rear of the building and the nurse will bring the medication to the door. No parents will be admitted to the building.

Lunch Account Balances: Just a reminder that all remaining balances in students' lunch accounts roll over to next year. You may check the balance on your child's EZpay account at any time. Remaining funds can be transferred to a sibling at any other school in the district or families may request a refund. To transfer funds to a sibling or to request a refund, click on the Contact Us Link in EZpay. Select Request Refund/Transfer and complete the online request form. Requests for refunds must be made prior to June 8.

We look forward to seeing our students the week of June 1.
