

Dear Solon High School 9-11 Grade Students and Families,

Below please find the schedule for the final 4<sup>th</sup> quarter assessments of the school year. Similar to mid-term exams, we will be utilizing a testing schedule.

All Solon High School classes will be administering an assessment of some type during these three days that will count toward the assessment component of students' fourth quarter grades. This is NOT a summative assessment for the second semester. This is simply an assessment over the final chapter/unit/material that was covered during the final weeks of school. Teachers have been instructed not to give a major assessment the week prior to June 1-3. All of these final fourth quarter assessments will be administered by the class period schedule below. Students are only expected to attend school during the periods they have classes scheduled. Students do NOT need to attend during their study hall periods.
