Antoine Campbell Named New Solon Middle School Principal

The Solon Board of Education today approved Antoine Campbell as principal of Solon Middle School effective August 1. He will be stepping into the position when current principal Scott Hatteberg retires this summer.

“We are excited to see Antoine build on his vision at Solon Middle School that supports the needs of every student,” said Solon Schools Superintendent Fred Bolden. “He is a strong, collaborative educational leader with exceptional interpersonal skills and is a valued member of our administrative team. Most importantly, Antoine is a student-first administrator, who will continue to focus on fostering a collaborative and supportive school culture.”

Mr. Campbell joined the Solon Schools in 2008 as an assistant principal at Solon High School. He moved to Solon Middle School in that same role in 2015.

“Antoine’s move to Solon Middle School six years ago was intentional,” Mr Bolden explained. “His experience, success and interest in working with middle school students is a perfect fit and looking ahead in 2015, we believed he would be the right person to lead SMS when Mr. Hatteberg retired.”

“Our Solon Middle School staff works tirelessly every day to create a positive and safe learning environment for our students,” Mr. Campbell said. “I am proud to be chosen to lead our SMS team in the next chapter of our success and the shared goal of meeting the needs of every student every day.”

Mr. Campbell joined the district from the Akron Schools, where he was a principal at the Akron Opportunity Center, an alternative school program for at-risk seventh and eighth grade students. He also worked as an assistant principal at Riedinger Middle School in Akron and in the Maple Heights City Schools. Mr. Campbell earned both his bachelor’s degree in education and his master’s in educational administration from the University of Ashland.
