

## **ACT Boot Camp Registration for SHS Juniors**

Dear SHS Junior Families:

As one of the Ohio graduation pathways, juniors (Class of 2023) are required to earn remediation-free math and English language arts scores on a nationally recognized college admission test such as ACT or SAT. To fulfill this college and career readiness component of their graduation requirements, our SHS juniors will all take the ACT in March 2022.

There is no cost to students to take this test because it is state funded. Details about test times, locations, etc. will be shared with students and families closer to the March test date. That day will not be a regular school day so we can have a focused, quiet and interruption-free testing environment for our juniors.

To help our students prepare for this high-stakes test, we are offering a one-day Mastery Prep ACT Boot Camp (IN PERSON) on Saturday, January 22, 2022. This session will focus on test-taking strategies, differentiating between the right answer and the best answer, spotting contradictions, making best guesses, time management and more.

The cost of this optional session is \$50. Student participants will engage in test prep for all sections of the ACT and receive a full-length test prep booklet. The high school administrative and guidance team believe this program is a valuable, low-cost opportunity for ACT preparation especially because the scores from the March test may be used for college admissions.

The session will run tentatively from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. in our SHS Lecture Hall.

Registration is required for this program. Student sign up runs through December 17, 2021 at the SHS Bookstore. Payment of \$50 must accompany registration. Checks should be made payable to Solon Board of Education.

No refunds are possible if registered students fail to attend the boot camp program.
