

6th Grade Camp Medication Requirements

1. No medication (prescription or non-prescription) will be given without a medication form completed and signed **by a physician and parent.**
2. A photo of your child **MUST** be attached to the medication form(s).
3. Medication **MUST** be in the original container/prescription bottle. Check expiration dates.
4. Only send the amount of medication your child will need for 2 days at camp.
5. If your child has a medication at school (Epi-pens, inhalers, daily), they will be sent to camp for your child.
6. Ibuprofen (Motrin) 200 mg and acetaminophen (Tylenol) 325 mg will be provided by the school if a non-prescription medication form has been completed and **signed by a physician and parent.**
7. All medication being sent to camp **MUST be in the clinic 2 weeks before** your child is scheduled to attend camp. **Parents** are to drop off medication and forms to the clinic nurse between 8:45 AM and 3:15 PM.
8. Any medications that are used while at camp, must be picked up from the nurse **the day your child returns from camp.**

*Medication ordered "as needed" MUST have a frequency indicated (Example: **every 4 hours** for headache or pain).
