



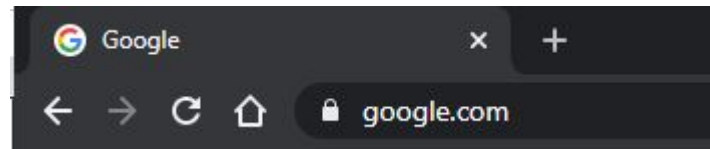

- Click on the Google Chrome browser icon

- Type www.google.com into the web address bar




Getting Started

- Click on **SIGN IN** on the upper right hand corner of the browser window




- Type in your child's Solon Schools email address:

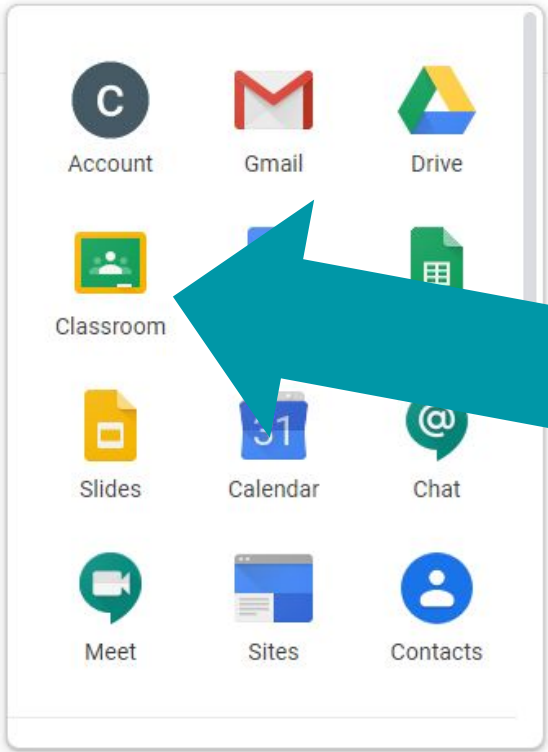
Getting Started





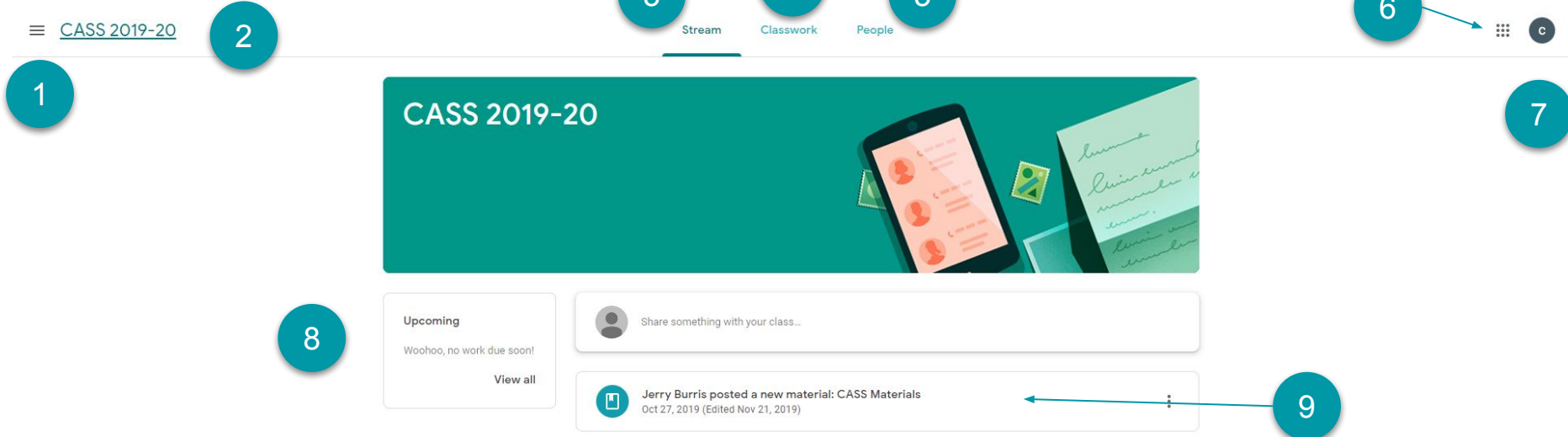
