Missions In Space

There are over 35 interesting space missions that NASA and other space agencies around the world had launched. Many scientists are studying and working on how to send humans to different planets to try to make humans be able to survive on other planets; and some are simply just studying the features of planets.

Voyager II

Pioneer Missions

The Pioneer probes were sent to space to explore Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune and beyond. Before the Pioneer probes were sent, scientist and astronomers knew very little about the planets beyond the asteroid belt.

Exploring Jupiter - Pioneer 10 was launched on March 2nd, 1972 from Spaceport Florida Launch Complex 36, in the Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. Pioneer 10 was a 569 pound (258 kilograms) probe launched by NASA. It was created around a hexagonal bus and carried a 2.74 meter diameter parabolic dish high-gain antenna. It was sent into space by an Atlas/Centaur/TE 364-4 launch vehicle. Pioneer 10 was not manned. It carried a gold-anodized aluminium plaque that was placed onto the body of the probe. The plaque was designed to show a picture of a man and a woman and some information to show the origin of the spacecraft. Pioneer 10 was the first spacecraft to travel through the Asteroid belt and to make direct observations of Jupiter. It was also the first spacecraft to obtain close up images of Jupiter. Right now it is now over 8 billion miles away. That's running around the earth 321,272 times.

Exploring Saturn - Pioneer 11 was launched on April 5th, 1973 from Spaceport Florida Launch Complex 36, in the Cape Canaveral Air Force Station. Pioneer 11 was a 571 pound (259 kilogram) probe also launched by NASA. It was also not manned. Its route through Saturn's outer rings brought it within 21,000 kilometers of the planet (which is very close), where it discovered two new moons (almost running into one of them). Pioneer 11 was sent to study the asteroid belt and the environment around Jupiter and Saturn. It was also sent to study solar wind and cosmic rays. It was the first probe to encounter Saturn and the second to fly through the asteroid belt. Thereafter, Pioneer 11 became the second artificial object of five artificial objects to achieve the escape velocity that allow it to leave the Solar System. Due to power constraints and the vast distance to the probe, the last routine contact with the spacecraft was on September 30, 1995, and the last good engineering data was received on November 24, 1995.

There were no Pioneer missions ever since 1973. The Pioneer mission sent scientists and astronomers on Earth a lot of information. Pioneer 10 is currently about 15.4 billion kilometers away from Earth. Pioneer 11 is about 12.4 billion kilometers from Earth. Pioneer 10 is on the exact opposite side of space from Pioneer 11. It is now impossible for scientists and astronomers

Voyager Missions

Voyager I and II have been sent to explore the planets beyond the Asteroid Belt and even the planets far beyond the Kuiper Belt. The main mission for the twin spacecraft was to study Jupiter and Saturn.

Voyager I was launched on September 5th, 1977. It also was not manned. Voyager I was sent to explore and collect information on the weather, magnetic fields and rings of two planets, Jupiter and Saturn. It was the first probe to provide detailed images of their moons. Voyager 1 carried a golden record on the side of the craft. The records carried 115 images and lots of sounds. They also added musical selections from different eras and spoken greetings from humans in fifty-five languages.

Voyager II (shown in picture above) was launched on August 20th, 1977. Voyager II is expected to provide the first direct measurements of the density and temperature of interstellar plasma, when it enters interstellar space. This will help astronomers and scientists know more on interstellar space. For example, astronomers and researchers have suspected that Titan has liquid water, so Voyager II will be sent to find out if it has water. The astronomers found out that Titan has a liquid under its thick icy surface.

There were no more Voyager missions ever since 1977. Even though the Voyager Mission was supposed to end when the probes reached interstellar space. When the probes reached interstellar space, the scientists thought the mission was worth to keep going, so they tried to keep contact with the probes. They also tried to repair any of the broken machinery.

Conclusion

The process of getting ready for these missions is hard. The scientists need to build and create the satellite or space telescope or probe, which takes a long time. Then they need to be able to communicate with the space vehicle in order to send commands and receive pictures. The scientists also need to angle the solar panels in the right direction so the space vehicle will be able to collect energy from the sun for the right amount of time. Undoubtedly, there will be many more space missions to come, as the interest in space exploration is increasing and the technology is advancing over time.


Thomas Jefferson's & John Adams' Trip to Shakespeare's birthplace

Artificial Intelligence

Have you ever wondered how Tesla cars drive by themselves or what goes on the top of your social media stream? Artificial Intelligence is the answer (AI for short). It is the software that lets robots and machinery think for themselves and learn like the human brain does. As new technology comes out AI is behind it. Elon Musk states that "The pace of progress in artificial intelligence is incredibly fast...it is growing at a pace close to exponential."

AI functions by obtaining large amounts of data and processes it through fast algorithms. This allows the software to draw conclusion, find patterns, etc. In much simpler terms it lets AI "think" by itself. AI can sometimes be smarter than a human because of its ability to "think". With this information, it outputs filtered data to carry out the process in other softwares or machines. Sometimes it gives signals to other databases to function. For example smart home speakers (Ok Google, Hey Siri, Alexa or Cortana) may use speech recognition to identify a person. This technology may carry out a certain function because that specific person is speaking. A much simpler example is in video games, for example Fortnite. During the "Fortnite Mares" event, zombies try to attack and run toward the players that are in a certain range. This is a simple form of AI because the game recognizes where the location of the player is and then tells the zombies to follow the player.

The base of the tech industry depends on AI. Most databases run on AI. For example:

- Portrait mode is an AI run camera option, that takes pictures as if it is a professional camera. The camera uses AI because it observes the setting in the photo, which adjusts the camera settings for the best picture.
- PvE games, which is player vs. computer generated opponents. Some examples are AI chess, Fortnite Save The World, and Minecraft. Another example of AI is AI chess. AI chess is nearly impossible to win, as it has consistently beat the world's top players.
- Siri suggestions is a feature on apple that views what apps you visit often, where you go regularly, etc. With this information it gives the user of the phone suggestions.
- Tesla cars use AI for their self-driving software. Sensors first make a profile of the cars surroundings. Then AI algorithms process the input and tell the car to function a certain way.

AI is the new definition of life. From listening to a radio in the car to scrolling down on Instagram, AI is everywhere. Anything where a computer makes a decision by itself is considered AI. Some conspiracy theories state that AI will stop listening to its programmers and take over the world. AI is expanding rapidly. Where will AI take itself next?

Elephants

You know how cars are made of metal, can be huge, and weigh a lot, right? Well, elephants are actually heavier than cars. There also no similar species to elephants. Read more to some new and interesting facts about these massive animals.



Ancestors

Of course, all animals that live today have ancestors.

After single-celled organisms became more complex, nature became more complex. Then came out woolly mammoths. Through scientific attempts, the data shows that woolly mammoths are more closely related to Asian elephants than to African elephants. The Asian elephant is also an ancestor of the straight-tusked elephant which lived in the pleistocene era (about 781,000-50,000 years ago). There definitely are other ancestors of elephants since there are several different types of elephants. This means, that there must be several different types of ancestors of the elephants. For example, the African elephants have come from the Stegodon. The Stegodon is believed to have shorter legs than the African elephants. Woolly mammoths had fur, modern Asian elephants mainly only has thick skin on the outside. But there were also ancestors of the Stegodon and the woolly mammoth. On the African elephant side, there was also the Mammut. There are more types, but these are just some of the earlier examples.

Homes

Elephants can live in Savannah deserts, grasslands, swamps, forests, mountains, tropical forests. The elephants have a wide variety of plants to eat and so if one species of plant dies out in their habitat, they have a lot more options of fruit benefiting their survival. They also live in elephant herds. Elephants live in herds because it ensures that the calves (young and baby elephants) of the herd are protected. African elephants tend to live in savanna grasslands. Asian elephants tend to live in forests. Originally, Asian elephants actually came from Ethiopia. Two species of asian elephants are the indian elephant and the borneo pygmy elephant. Two species of african elephants are the african bush elephant and the african forest elephant.

Food

Elephants can eat up to 200-600 lb. of food a day. Elephants usually eat 70,000 calories. The elephant can actually drink up to 50 gal. of water! They spend up to 80% of the day feeding! The tree bark is one of the elephants' favorite food. They also eat grass, small plants, fruit, roots, bushes, and some other plants. Elephants usually don't get eaten themselves, because of their large size, but lions could kill African elephants, while the Asian elephants could be eaten by tigers, but rarely for both elephants to get eaten.

Family

Female elephants that are related will form herds, and society, and form deep family bonds. The oldest and often largest female will become the leader of the herd or the matriarch. The male elephants though, they only spend 5% of their lifetime with the family herd, but they do spend a little time with other males that are alone. The males leave the herd at about 12-15 years old. There are typically 8-100 elephants in a herd.

Mating and Reproduction

Usually, the male elephant approaches the female elephant. If the female elephant is interested, then the female may leave the family group walking with her head up, and turn sideways to watch the male elephant following behind. The elephants will probably stroke their trunks before they mate. The male will stay near to guard the female for a few hours or even several days. Females have very long pregnancy, lasting up to 22 months. A female elephant may actually give birth to 12 elephants in a lifetime!



Fun Facts

Elephants are the largest land animal, and are heavier than cars. They can weight up to 13,000 lbs. They also measure up to 18-21 ft long. They can become as high as 11 ft. The African elephants can live up to 70 years old. Asian elephants however, can only live up to around 48 years old. However, captive elephants don't live as long as elephants in the wild. Captive males will only live up to 40 years old. And females live only to 19 years.



Rock hyra

The elephants' closest relative is the rock hyrax. The rock hyrax is also called a rock badger or rock rabbit, and is a medium-sized terrestrial mammal native to Africa and the Middle East. They are also related to manatees (sea cows).

Natural Disasters and How They Happen

Have you ever thought about how deadly natural disasters happen? Natural disasters happen in all different kinds of ways, and they greatly affect our world.

Earthquake

Earthquakes can be either very calm, or very harmful. Earthquakes are caused by the Earth's tectonic plates. Tectonic plates are always moving very slowly. When they stick to each other due to a problem, the stress between the two creates an energy that gets released through the Earth's crust, that results in shaking in the world's surface. There are ratings to tell you how strong or weak a earthquake is. The ratings range from less than 2.5 all the way to over 8.0. If you have a rating of 2.5 or less, then it's a very minor earthquake, and most of the time you won't even feel it. If it is 2.5 to 5.4, then the earthquake can be felt, but it usually doesn't give that much damage. 5.5 to 6.0 means it may give some damage. 6.1 to 6.9 means the earthquake will cause a lot of damage. 7.0 to 7.9 means it is a major earthquake and and there will be a lot of damage. Lastly, 8.0 or greater is a very, very, very bad earthquake that can damage a whole city. There have been many harmful earthquakes throughout time. For example, the San Francisco earthquake in 1906, or the Japan Earthquake of 1923. But those two earthquakes are not the only ones. There have been many people affected by this dangerous natural disaster.

Tsunami

Tsunamis are usually caused by underwater earthquakes. This is why most tsunamis happen a little bit after an earthquake. Tsunamis happen also because of the Earth's tectonic plates, getting stuck together and creating a wave of energy that turns into shaking on the earth's surface. The earthquake may happen underneath the ocean, which is why the waves reach such great heights. There have been many tsunamis in the world, and meteorologists have figured out many ways to know when a tsunami might happen.

Tornado

Tornadoes can be a very dangerous natural disaster. Tornadoes happen by very, very strong winds changing directions and speeds. Their speeds can reach higher than 250 mph! Because of these super strong winds, anything a tornado touches, will easily be wrecked to pieces. Most tornadoes happen after a severe thunderstorm, flash floods, or severe winds. Most meteorologists are starting to recognize that these severe storms are signs of a tornado.

Hurricane

Hurricanes are caused by water vapor that releases energy when the water vapor condenses and forms liquid drops. They usually form over oceans, and eventually make their way to land. An interesting fact

about hurricanes, is that the water has to be at least 80 degrees fahrenheit within 50 meters of the ocean's surface in order for the hurricane to form at all. This fact about these natural disasters can actually be potentially dangerous. Because of global warming, the temperatures of the ocean's are getting higher, which gives a better chance for hurricanes, or even Cyclones which most of the time are worse than hurricanes. Hurricanes also have a rating based on how strong the hurricane is. The rating is in numbers 1 through 5, with 1 being the weakest and 5 being the strongest. Hurricanes are a very strong natural disaster.

Scientists Help

Scientists nowadays are doing everything they can to predict when a natural disaster may come. For example, scientists are starting to know that severe thunderstorms or winds may be signs of tornadoes. They are also learning the signs of tsunamis are earthquakes.

Natural disasters are a very important topic to learn about. Learning about them saves lives. So, what can you do to save people worldwide?





Yes! HW should be banned!


- ★ Some people think homework is for no reason.

Harry Potter Day



New Year's







In the fourth the Bears tied it up at 27 with a Cody Parkey field goal, a successful onside kick, and with a Tarik Cohen TD pass to Anthony Miller as time expired. The Bears fell short with a field goal in OT by the Giants. Final score 27 to 30.

Jets vs Titans - The Jets started good in this one, as they scored 10 on the Tennessee defense before the first quarter ended. But after they scored 6 each in the second quarter with field goals, it was 16-6 at the half. But the Titans would not give up, as they cut the lead to 9 and eventually 3. And as time expired, Marcus Mariota threw a touchdown and the Titans won 26-22.

Chargers @ Steelers - The Chargers traveled to Pittsburgh to play the Steelers in an epic showdown. But in the first half, this was all but that. Yes, the Chargers scored a subpar 7 points, but their very good defense gave up 23 to the Steelers, capped off by 2 TDs from Ben Roethlisberger to Antonio Brown and a rushing touchdown from James Conner, making it 23-7 Pittsburgh at half. But the Chargers, led by veteran Philip Rivers, made a comeback with 2 TD's and 2 2-point conversions and single handedly tied the game at 23. And then they took the lead with a Justin Jackson rushing touchdown. But Big Ben threw a TD, and just like that, it was 30-30. The Chargers drove to field goal range and attempted a field goal to win the game. But something weird happened. And here are some of the rules for a field goal/touchdown winner situation.

- If the clock expires and there is a penalty on the defensive team, there will be an untimed down(the game play clock doesn't run) and if you attempted a field goal, the field goal will be 5 yards closer(if you are at your opponents' 25 yard line, you would be moved to their 20)
- If there is an offensive penalty and the offensive team does make a field goal, there will be a re-kick moved 5 yards back.
- If the team makes it, and there is a penalty on the defensive team, they will decline it and therefore make the field goal valid.

• If there is a delay of game, there will be 10 seconds taken off the clock. If this had happened to the Chargers(with 3 seconds left) they would've lost.

So Michael Badgley, the rookie from Miami, tried to kick a 39-yard field goal from the 21-yard line of the Steelers, and missed it. Wait a second......one of the players on the defense was offside!(Before the center snapped it to the holder, one of the defensive players started early). This player was Joe Haden and they kicked again from 34-yards away. But it got blocked. Wait.. another player was offside?!?!?! This was Artie Burns. So they moved it to the 11 yard line to attempt a 29-yard field goal and he made it. Wait.. there's another offside?!?! On the same person?!?!(Artie Burns). So the Chargers declined the penalty and won 33-30.

Week 14

Dolphins vs Patriots - This would turn out to be an epic showdown in Miami. Miami wanted to get over .500. The Patriots needed some room on surging Houston. So in the first quarter a "Browns TD" (no extra point) was scored by the Patriots and the Dolphins scored a TD and made the extra point. It's 7-6. And Tom Brady and Ryan Tannehill have a slugfest after that. Miami was trailing 27-21 at the half, and quickly regained it at the end of the third quarter and led 28-27. And after the Pats scored two field goals, the Dolphins performed what is now known as "Miracle in Miami". Ryan Tannehill completed a 17-yard pass to Kenny Stills. Then he lateraled it(to shove it) to DeVante Parker, who then threw it to Kenyan Drake. Drake avoided 3 tackles, and the safety.....Rob Gronkowski. Wait, Rob Gronkowski is a safety? Week 15

Eagles @ Rams - Everyone thought the Eagles were done. For good. But in this game, they held on tight. They held the Rams to a 13-13 tie at the half. But after the third quarter, they led 30-13. The Rams' comeback was unsuccessful, and the Eagles won in LA 30-23.

Steelers vs Patriots - This game was a rematch of the 2017 game. And the Steelers needed to eliminate the Browns from their AFC North crown. And after a long-fought battle, the Steelers won 17-10 stopping the Pats on 4th and 5 with less than a minute left.

Saints @ Panthers - The Panthers are trying hard to keep the playoff hopes strong. The Saints need to clinch a first-round bye. So the showdown in Carolina started off with a Carolina touchdown and 2 field goals by the Saints, and the score was 7-6 at half. Then the Saints scored a touchdown, and on the 2 point conversion, Drew Brees threw a interception and the cornerback returned it for a safety(2 points). And after the Panthers' offense were halted 3 times, the Saints won 12-9.

Week 16

Texans @ Eagles - In Philly, the Eagles were trying to keep playoff hopes alive. The Texans were trying to seal the division. In the fourth, the Eagles surprisingly led 29-16 but after 2 Texans touchdowns to make it 30-29 and a Nick Foles injury, it looked like the Eagles were out. But Foles came back into the game and Jake Elliott nailed the game-winning field goal to win 32-30.

Steelers @ Saints- The Steelers are trying to close the division with a win today and at the Bengals. But the Saints, led by tailback Alvin Kamara, QB Drew Brees, and the defense, led 3 at the half(17-14), but then trailed by 4 entering the fourth(28-24). But Drew Brees engineered a drive that ended with a touchdown. And after the Steelers fumbled, the Saints won 31-28.

Jets vs Packers - This game turned out to be a classic in MetLife Stadium. The Jets only led by 4 at the half(21-17); however, they led by 15 to start the fourth(35-20). It looked like that Aaron Rodgers was done for good. But no. He had 2 rushing touchdowns(yes, in the fourth quarter), an extra point, a converted 2 point conversion, and a field goal by Mason Crosby and the Packers overcame a deficit of 15 to lead by 3, 38-35. And after Pro Bowl kicker Jason Myers made a field goal to send it into OT, the Packers scored a touchdown and won in OT, 44-38.

Week 17

Browns vs Ravens - The Steelers, trailing by ½ games behind the Ravens in the AFC North, needed a Ravens loss paired with a win to win the division. But late in the half, a 27-7 lead was nullified by a fumble originally called a touchdown. So it was 20-7, and eventually the Browns cut it with 10 points of their own, and after only surrendering two field goals, the score was 26-17. And after the Browns scored and forced a Ravens punt, it looked like the division dream for Pittsburgh would become a reality. But after an interception by C.J. Mosley on 4th down, Baltimore sealed the division, clinching the 4 seed.

Cowboys vs Giants - This was a useless game for the Cowboys(they don't want injured players out for the playoffs), who had already locked the NFC East. But they played the majority of their starters, and they won 36-35.

Colts vs Titans - The winner goes to play the Texans in Houston. The loser stays home on the couch. The Titans, without star QB Marcus Mariota, put up a hard fight and only trailed by 7 entering the fourth quarter. But after the Colts scored 9 of their own, they won 33-17.

Playoff Games Are Set!!!!!!

Rules:

• 2 conferences, 4 divisions/conference, 4 teams for each division

- Division winners in each conference are in playoffs, seeded by record(Wins to losses), and tiebreakers. For example, if one division winner had a record of 12-4 and the other division winner had a record of 11-5, then the team with a 12-4 record would be ahead of the other team with a 11-5 record.
- 2 best non-division winners enter playoffs(based on record)
- Tiebreakers are used for same record.
- Top 2 division winners get a first round bye
- There are a maximum of four rounds(In order: Wild Card(4 games), Divisional Playoff(4 games), Conference Championship(2 games), Super Bowl)
- The 2 seed gets a first round bye, but has to face the highest seeded team after the 3rd seed plays the 6 seed, and the 4 seed faces the 5 seed.
- The 1 seed gets a first round bye, and gets to face the lowest seeded team.
- The 3 v 6 match basically determines one Top 2 Team's matchup(if the 3 seed wins, they play No. 2, and if the 6 seed wins, they play the No. 1 seed)

- 1. Chiefs, 12-4, AFC West WINNER
- 2. Patriots, 11-5, AFC East WINNER
- 3. Texans, 11-5, AFC South WINNER
- 4. Ravens, 10-6, AFC North WINNER
- 5. Chargers, 12-4, AFC West Runner-up
- 6. Colts, 10-6, AFC South Runner-up

NFC

- 1. Saints, 13-3, NFC South WINNER
- 2. Rams, 13-3, NFC West WINNER
- 3. Bears, 12-4, NFC North WINNER
- 4. Cowboys, 10-6, NFC East WINNER
- 5. Seahawks, 10-6, NFC West Runner-up
- 6. Eagles, 9-7, NFC East Runner-up

The Hunt for the Number 6

In the NFL, 6 teams from each conference make the playoffs. But even if you are extremely good you may not get what you like. The seeds are as shown for each conference.

- 1. First round-bye, home-field advantage throughout playoff run, best division winner
- 2. First round-bye(against 3/4/5), 2nd best division winner
- 3. Wild card round(vs 6), 2nd worst division winner
- 4. Wild card round(vs 5), worst division winner
- 5. Wild card round(vs 4), best division runner-up
- 6. Wild card round(vs 3), 2nd best division runner up or best third place team in division(this happened in 2017, when the Falcons, Saints, and Panthers made the playoffs, all from the NFC South).

So right now in the AFC seeds 1 and 5 have been taken. But there are a few teams fighting for the 6 seed. They are the Colts, Titans, Dolphins and Browns. The Browns and Dolphins are eliminated with a loss, and the Colts are eliminated with a loss and a tie against Tennessee, and Tennessee needs to tie the Colts and lose in Week 16.

In the NFC, seeds 1,2, and 3 are taken. The Cowboys need to win out to get the 4 seed, the Eagles and Redskins need to win out and need the Vikings to lose out. And the Panthers, it's a long shot. Here's what they need to do.

- Win out both games(at Falcons and at Saints)
- Eagles(vs Texans) and Redskins(vs Titans) need to lose their games(mentioned to their name), tie in last game(playing each other)
- Vikings lose out

If this were to happen, then the Panthers would likely be playing the Bears as the 6 seed.


All other teams not mentioned are out of the playoffs(with exception of the Falcons).









